How to choose your courses?

Click on the link https://formations.parisnanterre.fr/fr/catalogue-des-formations.html to access the course and training catalogue. The catalogue for the current year and the following year will be available from December (subject to availability). In principle, there are few changes from one year to the next as part of the accreditation of the course offer (2020-2024) but it is important to refer to the academic year of your exchange.

You have two options for searching:

- consult the catalogue of courses open to exchange students
- consult the content of a course (in each course description, it will be specified whether the course is open to exchange students)

With the second option, you have the possibility to download in pdf format the course summary or the complete syllabus of the course ("teaching booklet"). Please note that the syllabus for the year +1 is usually only available from July onwards.





3.5) Time of year




<u>Please note:</u> make sure that the selected course is taught in the desired semester.

Semesters are counted from the 1st year of the Licence to the last year of the Master. The courses of the odd-numbered semesters (1,3,5,7,9) take place from September to January, the courses of the even-numbered semesters (2,4,6,8,10) take place from January to May







Glossary

ECTS: Indicates the number of credits obtained at the end of the course

Volume of Hours: corresponds to the total number of hours in the semester (or more rarely in the year)

Period of the year/ Période de l'année: Indicates the teaching period

Carrier stage / Etape porteuse :: Indicates the course to which this course belongs.

Apogée code: indicates the course reference in the schooling software

Pre-requisites/ Pré-requis: this part indicates whether you need specific knowledge to follow this course

Knowledge control/ Contrôle des connaissances: corresponds to the examination modalities.
